- 2 To be entitled "Student Government Scholarship Eligibility Act"
- 3 relating to amending the criteria for the Student Government
- 4 Scholarship.
- 5 WHEREAS: The current criteria for the Student Government
- 6 Scholarship in Chapter 302 Article II section (e) of the Student
- 7 Government Code of Laws states that applicants must not receive
- 8 any need-based grants, thereby excluding students who receive
- 9 need-based grants or funds from consideration for the
- 10 scholarship; and
- 11 WHEREAS: This criterion creates an inequitable barrier for
- 12 deserving students who rely on need-based aid to pursue this
- 13 scholarship; and

- 14 WHEREAS: Many qualified and deserving students may be excluded
- 15 from accessing financial assistance due to this restriction;
- **16** and
- 17 WHEREAS: It is imperative to promote equal opportunity for all
- 18 students seeking financial assistance for their education; and
- 19 WHEREAS: There is a viable solution to address this issue by
- 20 introducing a more inclusive eligibility criterion for the
- 21 Student Government Scholarship; therefore,
- 22 BE IT ENACTED: Chapter 300 Article II Section (e) of the Student
- 23 Government Code of Laws regarding the Student Government
- 24 Scholarship criteria be amended to remove the restriction on
- 25 receiving need-based grants as a disqualifying factor for
- 26 consideration of the Texas State Students Government Scholarship
- 27 and read as follows "Grants, Loans, scholarships, and work study
- 28 are forms of financial aid that applicants may be receiving";
- **29** and
- 30 BE IT FURTHER ENACTED: That this legislation be forwarded to the
- 31 Student Body President for further action.
