1 **A Resolution-**

2 To be known as "Texas State University Narcan Resolution",
3 relating to the recent implementation of Narcan Distribution at
4 both Texas State University campuses.

6 **WHEREAS:** The Student Government of Texas State University, on
7 behalf of the student body of Texas State University supports the
8 efforts of Texas State University Division of Student Success for
9 the recent implementation of a Permanent Narcan Distribution
10 Program at the San Marcos and Round rock campuses; and

11 **WHEREAS:** The Texas State University Health Services team
12 implemented a permanently funded Narcan Distribution Program named
13 "Campus Naloxone (Narcan) Distribution Program" in February 2024
14 for all students, faculty, and staff. This program also provides
15 training on how to administer Narcan and other valuable resources

16 for individuals who receive Narcan through this program via the
17 program's website as cited below; and

18 **WHEREAS:** Students, staff, and faculty at both Texas State
19 University campuses can feel better prepared in case of an opioid
20 overdose related emergency; and

21 **WHEREAS:** Individuals who choose to receive Narcan through this
22 program do not have to provide any personal information to receive
23 Narcan. The individual just goes up to one of the 3 locations on
24 the San Marcos campus and one location at the Round Rock Campus
25 which are located at the student health center, student recreation
26 center, and the Alkek "Ask Us" Desk, or at the Round Rock campus
27 in the Avery Building room 201; and

28 **WHEREAS:** Texas State University Division of Student Success has
29 taken a proactive approach to the systemic issue affecting the
30 youth across the country starting on our Campuses; therefore,

31 **BE IT RESOLVED:** The Student Government of Texas State University
32 is in full support of the implementation and permanence of the
33 "Campus Naloxone (Narcan) Distribution Program" at both Texas
34 State University campuses; and

35 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** This legislation be forwarded to the
36 Student Body President for further action.
