1 A Resolution-

- 2 To be known as "A Resolution to Elevate Outdoor Community Spaces
- 3 with the Implementation of Hammock Stands" relating to Texas
- 4 State's wealth of free green space and lack of outdoor community
- 5 and study spots.
- 6 WHEREAS: The Student Government of Texas State University, on
- 7 behalf of the student body would like to address the limited amount
- 8 of outdoor gathering spaces and lack of commuter-friendly leisure
- 9 areas; and
- 10 WHEREAS: According to surveys done by the campus master plan,
- 11 students have identified outdoor gathering spaces to be a top
- 12 priority for things they would like to see more of on campus.
- 13 Further, as an institution focused on integration with nature, it
- 14 is imperative that Texas State establishes lounge areas within
- 15 designated green spaces; and

- 16 WHEREAS: The National Health Institute has identified extremely
- 17 high levels of sleepiness and lack of sleep health among college
- 18 students and Texas State's counseling center has furthered this
- 19 research to specify that 43% of students are getting less than
- 20 seven hours of sleep per night; and
- 21 WHEREAS: Commuter students often struggle to find rest areas
- 22 between classes and without the proper allocation of time to return
- 23 home, they are constrained to the limited amount of cushioned
- 24 seating in Alkek or the uncomfortable, outdoor bench seating around
- 25 LBJ. Additionally, students have identified the West Mall
- 26 connector as having the potential to be a community area however
- 27 it lacks the seating to accomplish this effectively; and
- 28 WHEREAS: Installing 4 dynamic hammock stands that can
- 29 accommodate up to 16 people (8 large hammocks) in a few key
- 30 areas on campus could elevate the number of outdoor gathering
- 31 spaces and offer students more lounge options between classes or
- 32 after. The key spaces for potential placement are the East-West
- 33 mall connector, the open field by Harris, and between the Den and
- 34 JCK building. Branded Promo has maroon and gold hammocks that can
- 35 be purchased in bulk at a lower per unit cost to be placed on the
- 36 hammock stands which will allow for this resolution to be both
- 37 beneficial for students and cost-effective for the university; and

- 38 WHEREAS: Hammocks have proven health benefits including the
- 39 provision of improved sleep and the ability to fall asleep faster.
- 40 This will allow for the promotion of restful sleep and low-stress
- 41 areas to be installed on campus. Hammock stands allow students to
- 42 cultivate a closer sense of community with one another while also
- 43 appreciating the natural beauty Texas State's campus has to offer;
- 44 therefore,
- 45 BE IT RESOLVED: To increase student outdoor gathering spaces,
- 46 supply commuter students with adequate rest areas, and provide
- 47 students with ways to embrace the natural beauty on campus, 4
- 48 hammock stands with the capacity to seat 16 students shall be
- 49 placed in appropriate green areas (viable options including East-
- 50 West mall connector, the open field by Harris, and between the Den
- 51 and JCK building); and
- 52 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: This legislation be forwarded to the
- 53 Student Body President for further action.
