2 To be known as "A Resolution in support of Anthology Engage at
3 Texas State University", relating to the new comprehensive
4 student involvement and engagement platform launching at Texas
5 State University.

6 **WHEREAS:** The Student Government of Texas State University, on

8 address the current platform being used to manage information and
9 activities related to recognized student organizations; and

10 **WHEREAS:** The current system used to manage recognized student
11 organizations on campus is Canvas which is also used to manage
12 academic courses and courseware; and

13 **WHEREAS:** Anthology Engage will be a separate platform from academic
14 courseware and will be able to serve student organizations as a
15 platform to manage student organization affairs such as event
16 posting and marketing, event registration, attendance tracking

17 tools, outreach, news story posting, and policy and procedure
18 training; and

19 **WHEREAS:** Anthology Engage is going to streamline student
20 organization operations at Texas State University by enhancing the
21 student organization management and administration capabilities
22 and participation data collection; and
