

Withdrawal Refunds

Reducing semester credit hours to zero is considered a withdrawal and withdrawal refund policies apply. You **MUST** do this through the [Registrar's Office](#). Students receiving financial aid must contact [TXST One Stop](#).

December Intersession - Withdrawals

| | Owed | Refunded |
|---------------------------|-------------|-----------------|
| First Class Day - Dec 18 | 20% | 80% |
| Second Class Day – Dec 19 | 50% | 50% |
| After 2nd class day | 100% | 0% |

Spring Semester - Withdrawals

| | Owed | Refunded |
|-----------------------------------|-------------|-----------------|
| Class Days (1-5) Jan 13 – Jan 20 | 20% | 80% |
| Class Days (6-10) Jan 21 - Jan 27 | 30% | 70% |
| Class Days (11-15) Jan 28 – Feb 3 | 50% | 50% |
| Class Days (16-20) Feb 4 – Feb 10 | 75% | 25% |
| After 20th class day | 100% | 0% |

First 8-Week Withdrawals

| | Owed | Refunded |
|----------------------------------|-------------|-----------------|
| Class Days (1-3) Jan 13 – Jan 15 | 20% | 80% |
| Class Days (4-6) Jan 16 – Jan 21 | 50% | 50% |
| After 6th class day | 100% | 0% |

Second 8-Week Withdrawals

| | Owed | Refunded |
|--------------------------------|-------------|-----------------|
| Class Days (1-3) Mar 4 – Mar 6 | 20% | 80% |
| Class Days (4-6) Mar 7– Mar 18 | 50% | 50% |
| After 6th class day | 100% | 0% |

The refund percentages are applicable to all tuition and fees except non-refundable fees including late fees and orientation fees. Refunds of parking fees must be requested at the [Parking Services Office](#). Housing and meal plan refunds are prorated through the [Department of Housing & Residential Life](#) and [ID Services](#) respectively.

An immediate refund **WILL NOT** be made at the time a student withdraws. Any refund will be applied to remaining unpaid obligations. If a student has paid in full, a refund will be processed within 30 days. For other refund information, please visit the [TXST One Stop](#) website.
