Academic Affairs Council Meeting January 25, 2025 Summary and Action Items

- Overview of the Inaugural Texas State University Research Showcase Dr. Aimee Roundtree provided a brief overview of the upcoming Texas State University Research Showcase on February 10, 2025. The schedule of events can be found on the Research Showcase website.
- **Students Applying for Closed Scholarships** A brief discussion was held regarding students applying for closed scholarships.
- **Budget Hearings** Mr. Brendan Scott provided the deans with more information regarding the upcoming budget hearings scheduled for March 7, 2025.
- **Undergraduate Admissions Report** Mr. Gary Ray provided the Council with an undergraduate admissions report. Highlights are as follows:
 - Spring 2025 enrollment will set an institutional record, surpassing the previous record of 35,847 set in 2017
 - Current SCH for spring 2025 is 472,984 which surpasses SCH in spring 2024 which was 437,040
 - We have 1,760 new students compared to 1,420 in spring 2024, an increase of 340 or 23.9%

- New Student Orientation for fall 2025 opens February 3rd.
- Tarrant County Community College signing ceremony scheduled for February 17
- **Graduate Admissions Report** Dr. Andrea Golato provided the Council with a graduate admissions report. Highlights are as follows:
 - For spring 2025, overall enrollment is up 10.5%
 - For fall 2025, applications are up significantly as well as applications for the RRC and international student applications
 - Merit scholarships will be awarded soon
