## A Resolution-

2 To be known as "A Resolution Proposing Enhanced Internet Within
3 Auditorium Lecture Halls". Relating to poor internet performance
4 among multiple 200+ student teaching theaters.

6 WHEREAS: The Student Government of Texas State University, on 7 behalf of the student body of Texas State University would like to 8 address the internet quality within large scale teaching 9 auditoriums such as 'Alkek Teaching Theater', 'LBJ Teaching 10 Theater', 'Centennial Teaching Theater', and many McCoy, Trauth 11 Huffman, Academic Services, and Evans Liberal Arts Auditoriums; 12 and,

13 WHEREAS: The current auditoriums are not up to modern internet 14 standards such that when there are high levels of internet traffic, 15 electronic devices of various make and models are not able to 16 adequately transfer data between Texas State's internet system and 17 personal devices; and, 18 WHEREAS: The issue is prominent when combined with students 19 attempting to remedy the situation by starting up their own 20 personal hotspot which further worsens the issue causing 21 interference with Texas State's internet systems; and,

WHEREAS: A solution is proposed such that the internet systems within auditorium lecture halls are improved to accommodate a larger class size allowing small, internet related, interruptions to be avoided in the 'Alkek Teaching Theater', 'LBJ Teaching Theater', 'Centennial Teaching Theater', and many McCoy, Trauth Huffman, Academic Services, and Evans Liberal Arts Auditoriums; therefore,

29 BE IT RESOLVED: To enhance student learning experiences, a more 30 up-to-date Texas State internet network while within auditorium 31 lecture halls is necessary, The Student Government recommends that 32 the aforementioned student teaching theaters be modernized with 33 the current network infrastructure to keep Texas State up to date 34 with modern day internet requirements; and

35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: This legislation be forwarded to the36 Student Body President for further action.
