Awardees will be those who have gone beyond their typical responsibilities to collaborate with departments within the Division, fostering an environment where students thrive both on-campus and in the broader community. Nominees will be evaluated on their alignment with the Student Success Framework, which includes:

- **Basic Needs**: Supporting students' financial wellness, housing, food security, and resource access.
- Academic Pathway: Helping students navigate their academic journey and master skills for success.
- Individual Connections: Fostering positive relationships among students, faculty, and staff.
- **Community Engagement**: Strengthening students' sense of belonging both at the university and in the local community.
- **Health and Well-being**: Supporting students' emotional and physical wellness.
- Career-Related Engagement: Promoting career exploration and professional development.
