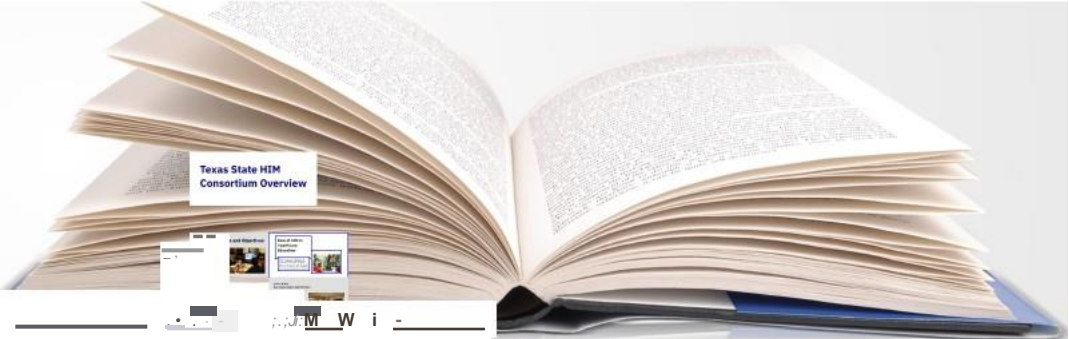

Introduction of Presenters & Panelists

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Definition and Importance

Open Educational Resources (OER) are freely accessible, openly licensed materials that facilitate teaching, learning, and assessment. OER hold significance as they promote equity in education by reducing costs and expanding access to quality educational materials for diverse learners.





Benefits for Students and Educators

Students benefit from OER via reduced textbook costs and increased access to supplementary learning materials, fostering academic success. Educators enjoy the flexibility of adapting and customizing resources to meet diverse learner needs, ultimately enhancing instructional quality.



Financial Savings & An Example from Davenport

- For Example - The Open Education Network (OEN) calculates student savings from open textbook adoptions by multiplying enrollment by \$100
- Formula: $\$100 \times \text{number of students} = \text{cost savings}$

Current Trends in OER

Current trends in OER highlight a shift towards collaborative content creation and adoption of technology-enhanced resources. The proliferation of digital platforms and open licenses supports greater dissemination and innovation in educational practices, leading to wider OER adoption.

Challenges in Implementation

Despite their potential, the implementation of OER faces challenges, including institutional resistance and a lack of awareness among educators. Additionally, ensuring quality assurance and sustainability of resources poses significant hurdles for educational institutions. There can be invisible labor involved that deserves recognition.
