**NOTICE OF COMPLAINT**

**SUBJECT:** Election Code Violations

The Supreme Court has received a complaint from a petitioner that your campaign has violated the Campaigning Regulations as set by the Election Code and the Supreme Court. The petitioner alleged that:

- 1- Antonio Romo posted an Instagram story on his private account promoting all the candidates of the Bobcat First Alliance. This was done on March 27<sup>th</sup>, during the designated voting period.

The petitioner alleged that this is a violation of our memorandum issued on March 26<sup>th</sup>, where we held that any active campaigning during the voting period would constitute as 3 Class A violations.

The Court has unanimously voted on dismissing this complaint.

In accordance with our change of procedures to accommodate election certification in a timely manner, a detailed opinion on this dismissal will be issued at a later date (past the 24-hour deadline to issue opinions).

Please accept this as an official dismissal of the complaint.
