The Supreme Court has received a complaint from a petitioner that your campaign has violated the Campaigning Regulations as set by the Election Code and the Supreme Court. The petitioner alleged that:

1- Antonio Romo posted an Instagram story on his private account promoting all the candidates of the Bobcat First Alliance. This was done on March 27th, during the designated voting period.

The petitioner alleged that this is a violation of our memorandum issued on March 26th, where we held that any active campaigning during the voting period would constitute as 3 Class A violations.

The Court has unanimously voted on dismissing this complaint.

In accordance with our change of procedures to accommodate election certification in a timely manner, a detailed opinion on this dismissal will be issued at a later date (past the 24-hour deadline to issue opinions).
