SUBJECT: Election Code Violations

The Supreme Court has received, and accepted for hearing, two complaints from a petitioner that your campaign has violated the election rules as established by the Election Code and the Supreme Court. The statements of the complaints filed are as follows:

- 1- “A voting link was added to their Instagram bios after the end of the voting period. As this link did not previously exist, this is in violation of the memorandum issued by the Court.”
- 2- “After adding the link, the Instagram account followed a lot of new accounts. This is campaigning and was done after the ending of the campaign period.”

The petitioner alleges that both these constitute as campaigning and are a violation of the Code of Laws and the Memorandum issued by the Court on March 26th, 2025. The Court has deemed any campaigning during the voting period to constitute as 3 Class A violations.

The hearing for this case will be held virtually at 2:00 pm, Sunday, March 30th, 2025.

If the petitioner or defendant cannot attend at this time, they can authorize someone to speak on their behalf. They must submit, via email, a written permission to the Court before the meeting. The Court will still move on with a decision regardless of attendance at this hearing.
