## NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

**SUBJECT:** Election Code Violations

**DATE:** 03/28/2025

The Supreme Court has received, and accepted for hearing, a complaint from a petitioner that your campaign has violated the election rules as established by the Election Code and the Supreme Court. The statements of the complaints filed are as follows:

1- "Carolina Estrada (a registered campaign agent for the Abby Myers campaign) reposted an Instagram post from the Bobcat First Alliance page. This post was about her work as an agent for the campaign. This was allegedly reposted on Miss Estrada's story after the campaign period had ended."

The petitioner alleges that this constitutes campaigning and is a violation of the Code of Laws and the Memorandum issued by the Court on March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Any campaigning during the voting period would constitute 3 Class A violations.

Since Miss Estrada is a registered campaign agent for the Abby Myers campaign, a ruling against Miss Estrada will be a ruling against Miss Myers.

The hearing for this case will be held virtually at 4:00 pm, Sunday, March 30th, 2025.

If the petitioner or defendant cannot attend at this time, they can authorize someone to speak on their behalf. They must submit, via email, a written permission to the Court before the meeting. The Court will still move on with a decision regardless of attendance at this hearing.
