

The required RESEARCH SECURITY PROGRAM training is available online via the <u>Collaborative</u> <u>Institutional Training Initiative (CITI)</u>. Once investigators complete the tutorial, CITI records your certification and then provides a record to Research Compliance and Integrity.

If you previously created an account in CITI:

- Visit the Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) website.
- Click "LOG IN THROUGH MY ORGANIZATION"
- Login with your NetID username and password.
- Click "View Courses" box next to "Texas State University"
- On your home page, under "Learner Tools for Texas State University" click "Add a Course"
- On the next page, scroll down and select the appropriate selection to Question 9 Research Security; then click Submit to enroll.
- Follow the prompts to complete the tutorial and brief quizzes.
- You may print a completion certificate for your own records. The system will provide our office with a report of your training.

If you never created an account in CITI:

- 1. Visit the **Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI)** website.
- 2. Register and create your own username and password.
- 3. Select Texas State University as your institution.
- Select the appropriate selection to Question 9 Research Security; then click submit to enroll.
- 5. Follow the prompts to complete the tutorial and brief quizzes.
- 6. You may print a completion certificate for your own records. The system will provide our office with a report of your training.
