Dear prospective and returning Bobcat Marching Band Members,

Greetings from San Marcos! As the directors of the Bobcat Marching Band (BMB), we would like to welcome you all to a collegiate family like none other. The BMB has established an outstanding reputation at the regional and national level for its exciting, challenging, and artistic shows, as well as creating a spirited environment for Bobcat Football game days! Please take a moment to carefully go over all the material in the packet.

FORMS & REGISTRATION – Several forms are required to participate in the BMB:

- Band Information Form (BIF) – only available online, due August 1
- Percussion Prescreening Audition Form & Videos – available online, due August 1
- A Medical Form will be distributed at Preseason Camp on arrival to campus in August
- ALL STUDENTS MUST BE REGISTERED FOR THE CLASS (MUSE 3120); see band website for additional info

ORDERING REQUIRED EQUIPMENT – Minimal equipment is required for BMB, and most of it is either provided free or ordered at preseason camp check-in. Look over the checklist in this packet to ensure you have (or will order) what you need for the season!

PRESEASON CAMP INFORMATION – A detailed preseason camp schedule is in this packet - come prepared! Be physically ready, mentally fired-up, and have all of the equipment that you need. It is important that preseason camp is the time for the band to focus on band, so you must have any administrative issues (financial aid, residence hall, registration, etc.) resolved prior to camp. If you need help, ask now. A few key details about preseason camp are listed below:


- Dorm Move-in is on **August 14 between 9 AM and 12 noon**. Members should report **DIRECTLY** to your assigned dorm. **IF YOU ARE IN BMB AND LIVING IN CAMPUS HOUSING, YOU MUST REPORT ON THIS DAY AND TIME!!**
- BMB check-in will take place in the afternoon on August 14 at the Music Building. Veteran members report at 1:00 PM, all new members report at 2:00 PM. All members **MUST** check in on this day!!
- All trumpet and trombone players will take a brief part assignment audition. Be prepared to play your full range via scales and bring a short prepared piece to play. (This happens on day one; trumpet and trombone players, bring your instrument to check-in!)
- Auditions for spots and scholarships will be held during the first few days of preseason camp if needed. PDFs of music are available on the band website so you can get a head start at: <http://www.txst.edu/bands/bands/marchingband/preseason-camp.html>
- Are you a new student that has Bobcat Welcome events? Don't worry! Dr. Glaser will give you specific instructions when you arrive for camp in August.
- The end of camp cookout & river day will be on August 23! Enjoy a San Marcos tradition by jumping in the river!
- Uniform distribution will be held on August 23 and 24. (See preseason camp schedule for details.)

The "Pride of the Hill Country" has been supporting Bobcat Spirit for over a century. The university has recognized your contribution to our school, as the administration has pledged scholarships for every selected member of the marching band. Let's make this year's edition of BMB the biggest and best ever! If you have friends who will be attending Texas State this year that played in high school band, encourage them to join us! It is important that recruiting be done in a timely fashion, so their enrollment deadline will be the same as yours. Have them contact we and we will get them all the information they need!

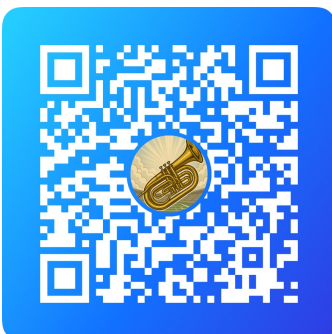

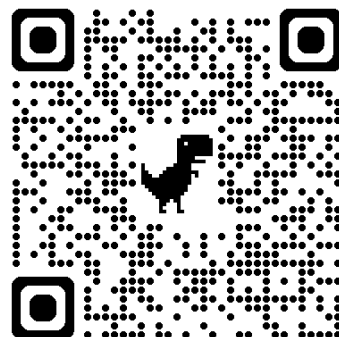

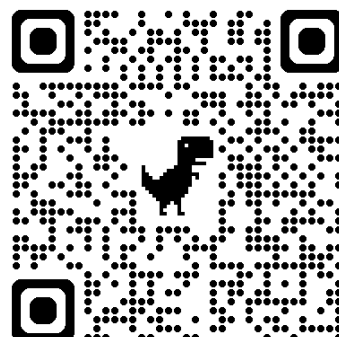
