What is good judicial demeanor?

Key qualities: fairness, impartiality, patience, professionalism, courtesy, and respect

Why?

- Perceptions of justice and legitimacy
- Impact on litigants, attorneys, witnesses, and the public

Judicial Demeanor in Practice

- · Maintaining order and decorum in the courtroom
- · Listening skills and communication with all parties
- Managing high-emotion situations and self-represented litigants
- Avoiding bias and ensuring equal treatment
- Common pitfalls: impatience, discourtesy, unconscious bias

Ensuring everyone can participate fully in the legal process, regardless of income, status, or ability

Why?

• Barriers to access: financial, procedural, technological, linguistic, and physical
