Visitor Guide

Thank you for your interest in our program. We do allow visitors for a FACTS lecture and a look around our indoor skeletal laboratory. The lecture covers FACTS, our center, our program, our research, and outreach. It includes a basic overview of forensic anthropology and decomposition. The lecture and tour take about 1.5-2 hrs total depending on questions. We can accommodate up to 25 students at a time. There is no cost. Students can purchase t-shirts if they choose for \$30.00 check or credit.

We also offer private workshops for groups of 10 or more students. M-F the cost is \$25.00 per student. For weekend workshops, the price is \$50.00 per student. This covers a 3 hour workshop with lecture and hands-on material. School group workshops usually focus on human osteology where the students learn about the human skeleton and then articulate a skeleton in groups. We also briefly review how we would analyze the skeleton for a biological profile in forensic anthropology casework. We can, however, customize a workshop to your specific needs. These workshops can be scheduled any day of the week and are not limited to visitor days.
