Nationwide math competition for middle school students

During the weekend of March 24th, the Texas state MathCounts competition was held in Austin, where more than 280 middle school students from across the state competed. Michael Ma, Stephen Price, Lazar Ilic, and Jeffrey Huang were named to the team to represent Texas in the national level of the contest on May 11th in Orlando, Florida. Ma, Price, and Ilic are alumni of the Mathworks residential Junior Summer Math Camp (JSMC). In total, we had 10 JSMC alumni who finished within the top 50 individuals at the state meet.
