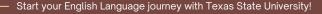


# **ESL Program**

Follow this Application Guide in order to successfully submit an application to join the Texas State University English Language Program.

# Part 1: Go to the Texas State University Application

First, you will go to the application page found on this webpage to create a TXST student account: <a href="https://recruit.admissions.txstate.edu/apply/">https://recruit.admissions.txstate.edu/apply/</a>

You will then fill out the information requested in the applicant information application and click "submit".

# Part 2: Confirm your temporary pin

Once the application is submitted, you will receive a temporary pin via e-mail. If you did not see any e-mail, check the junk or spam folder in your inbox.

You will then be required to enter that temporary pin and your birthdate into webpage that appears once you submit the application (example of that page provided below), to login.

# Part 4: Complete the English Language Application

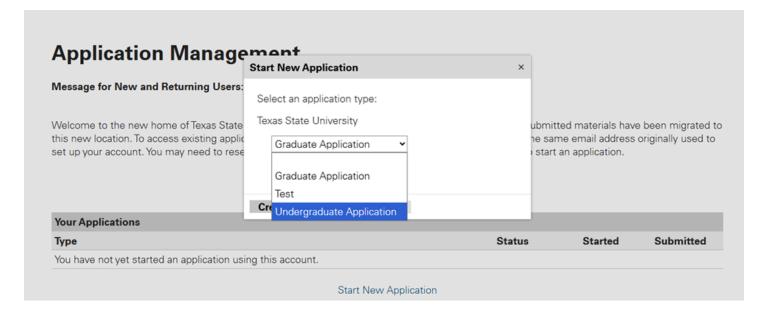



Then click "Create Application" and then "Open Application".



You will then be prompted to a "Student Type" webpage in which you will need to make sure you select "Yes" for the 2<sup>nd</sup> question "Are you applying for the ESL program"?
