- 3 to authorizing the Texas State Student Government budget for the
- 4 2025-2026 academic year in accordance with the Student
- 5 Government Constitution and Student Government Code.
- 7 WHEREAS: The Student Government of Texas State University has a
- 8 responsibility to transparently and democratically decide how its
- 9 funds are allocated; and
- 10 WHEREAS: In an effort to provide the best programs and services
- 11 and meet its constitutional requirement to represent the students
- 12 of Texas State University to the best of their abilities, the
- 13 Student Body President and Director of Finance have put together
- 14 the following budget proposal; and
- 15 WHEREAS: This bill has been compiled as prescribed by the Student
- 16 Government Constitution Article IV, Section One, and in compliance
- 17 with the regulations found in S.G.C. VIII. §100.4; therefore

18	BE TO ENACTED: That the S.G.C Title VIII § 101 - "Budget
19	Authorization Act of 2025" be amended as shown:
20	TITLE VIII - THE BUDGET
21	CHAPTER 101 - BUDGET AUTHORIZATION ACT OF 2025
22	ARTICLE I. ADMINISTRATIVE
23	MEETING AND PURPOSE: In order to provide oversight of the budget
24	and expenditures, the Finance Commission shall meet every week
25	starting the last week of August and while the Senate is in session
26	with the exception of holidays.
27	PRESIDENTIAL REPORTING: The President, the Director of Finance
28	or a designee shall provide the commission with documentation of
29	expenditures and issue a report on the state of the budget
30	including, but not limited to, current expenditures from each
31	category and line item at each meeting of the commission.
32	PRESIDENTIAL POWERS: The Student Body President shall have the
33	power to reallocate remaining funds from each category and line
34	item should the activity funded be completed or invalidated, with
35	any such changes reported to the Finance Commission at its next
36	regularly scheduled meeting.

37 ARTICLE II. AUTHORIZATION

38 **DEFINITION AND ORGANIZATION:** Where each word is bolded shall be considered a category of the budget and where each word is indented

- 40 it shall be considered a line item of the budget. The Student
