

Withdrawal Refunds

Second 8-Week Withdrawals

Class Days (4-6) Mar 13 – Mar 24	50%	50%
After 6th class day	100%	0%

The refund percentages are applicable to all tuition and fees except non-refundable fees including late fees and orientation fees.
