Biographical Notes

Joyce Gibson Roach was born December 18, 1935 in Jacksboro, Texas. She received a BFA in 1958 and an MA in 1964 from Texas Christian University. Having lived all her life in ranch country, Roach has had a lifelong interest in western folklore. She is active in the Texas Folklore Society of which she was president in 1976. She has contributed articles to magazines such as *Western Folklore*, *Horseman*, and *Southwest Heritage*. She received the Spur Award from Western Writers of America in 1977 for *The Cowgirls*.
