CACREP Student Outcome Data Summary for AY 2024-2025

The Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Education Programs (CACREP) first awarded accreditation to the Professional Counseling Program's degree programs at Texas State University in 2000, and the program has maintained CACREP accreditation ever since. Our most recent re-accreditation was granted in August 2025, with the Clinical Mental Health Counseling, Marriage, Couple, and Family Counseling, and School Counseling programs receiving accreditation for the full 8-year cycle, through October 31, 2032.

The following data from the AY 2024-2025 Summary Report submitted to CACREP for Fall 2024, Spring 2025, and Summer 2025 illustrate student outcomes.

Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CMHC) Program
