2025 USAPL Texas Collegiate State Championships

Last year, we placed 1st in the Women's Raw Division & 2nd in the Men's Raw Division. This year, we placed 3rd in the Women's Raw Division. The following athletes placed; Makayla Gregory placed 1st in the 44 KG weight class, Katarina Garza placed 3rd in the 52 KG weight class, Jayla Williams placed 3rd in the 90 KG weight class, Abdias Castillo won 1st place in the men's 110 KG weight class. Three TXSTPL athletes were drug tested during this meet.

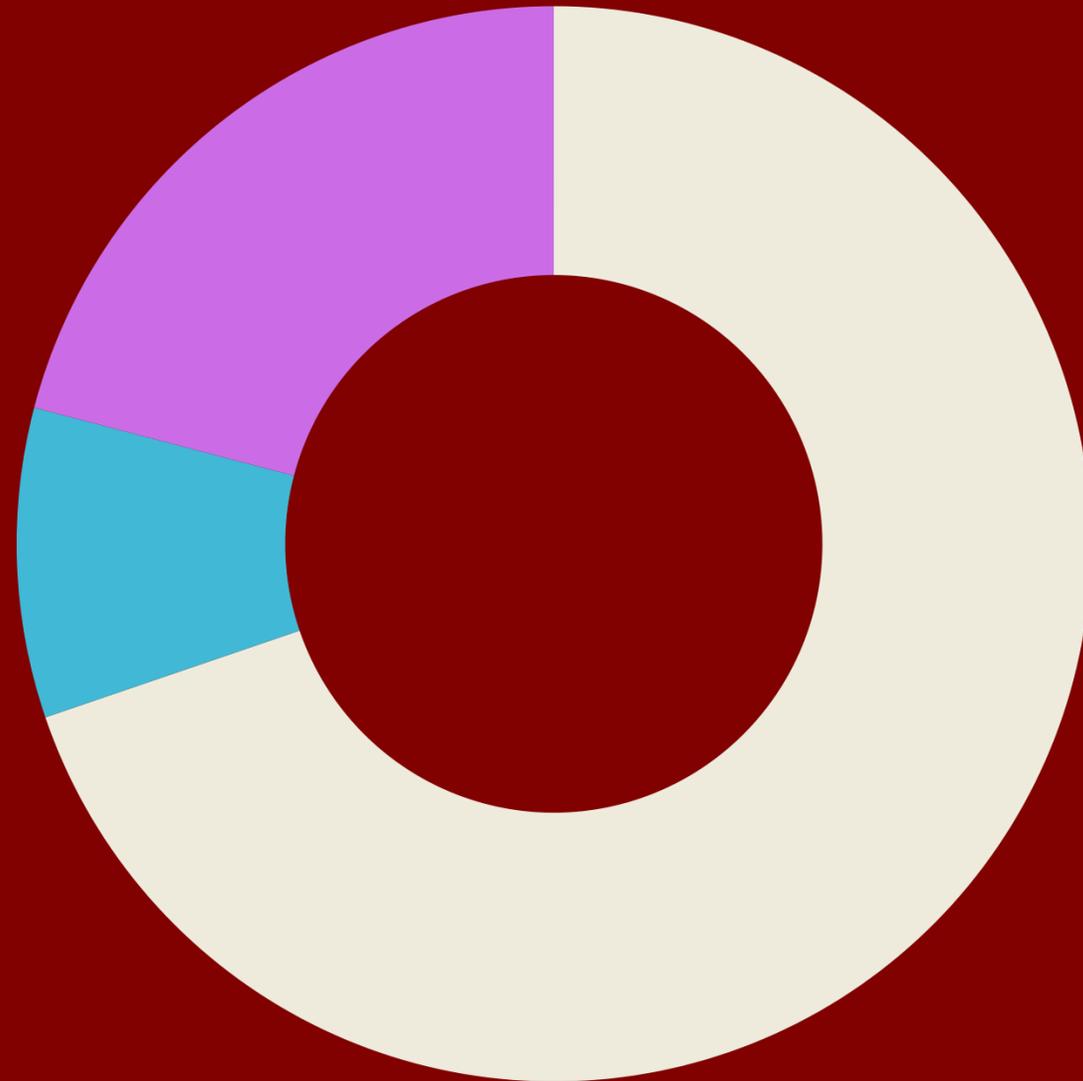

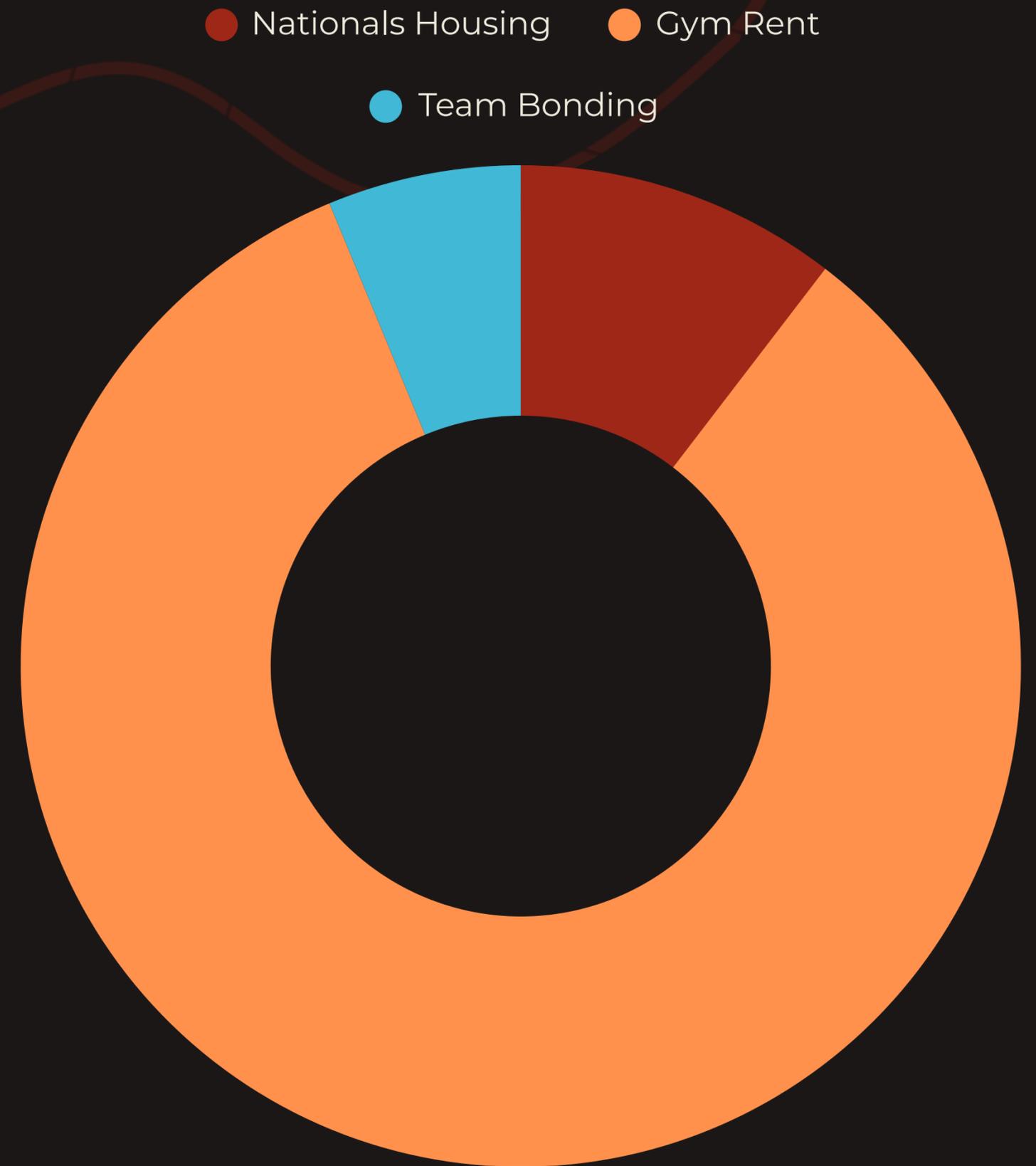
TOTAL: \$8,600

EXPENSES FALL 25

- Gym Rent: We paid a monthly rent of \$2,000 starting in October.
- Comp Shirt took up a good chunk of our budget costing \$1,800
- Team Bonding: We went bowling and had team pumpkin painting

EXPENSES SPRING 26

- Gym rent: The rent for the gym is \$2,000 a month which is taking up most of our budget.
- Team registration: \$200 (\$100 per division) for Nationals registration and \$95 for club re-registration with USAPL.
- Nationals housing: We will be expecting to bring 15-18 members to nationals which will make our cost around \$2,000 – \$2,500
- Team bonding: Social events including but not limited to bowling, team bond fires, movie nights, etc.

MONEY NEEDED FOR ALLOCATION

WE ARE ASKING FOR \$5,000 WHICH WILL BE GOING TO ONE MONTH OF GYM RENT (WHICH IS \$2,000 MONTHLY), REGISTRATION FOR NATIONALS (\$200) AND CLUB RE-REGISTRATION WITH USAPL (\$95), AND THE REST TO PAY FOR LODGING AT NATIONALS. THIS WILL HELP US HAVE ENOUGH MONEY TO PAY FOR THE REST OF THE SPRING SEMESTER'S GYM RENT AND WILL HELP US PAY FOR TRAVELING TO NATIONALS.
