Two Ways to Create Your Scholarship

Traditional Endowed Scholarship

- \$25,000 minimum, payable over 5 years
- Scholarship awarded after one year of fund growth
- Customize name and criteria through a formal MOU
- Receive annual updates on your recipient

McCoy Pay-It-Forward (PIF) Fund

- \$25,000 minimum, payable over 15 years
- Gifts are added to a pooled fund that awards scholarships each year
- Track your cumulative giving until your named scholarship is established
- Exclusive to McCoy College Foundation
