APPLIANCES

If a resident chooses to bring a mini-fridge or microwave, they are **required to use a power strip that includes surge protection** in order to reduce electrical outages

- Microwave:** Must be .7 cu. ft or less and have a 700-watt max.

College Inn, Falls Hall, San Jacinto Hall, San Marcos Hall, Sayers Hall:

One microwave per suite.

All other halls: One microwave per room.

- Mini-fridge:** Each resident may bring one 2.5 cu. ft. mini-fridge, OR two residents may share a 4.6 cu. ft. mini-fridge.
