Timeline

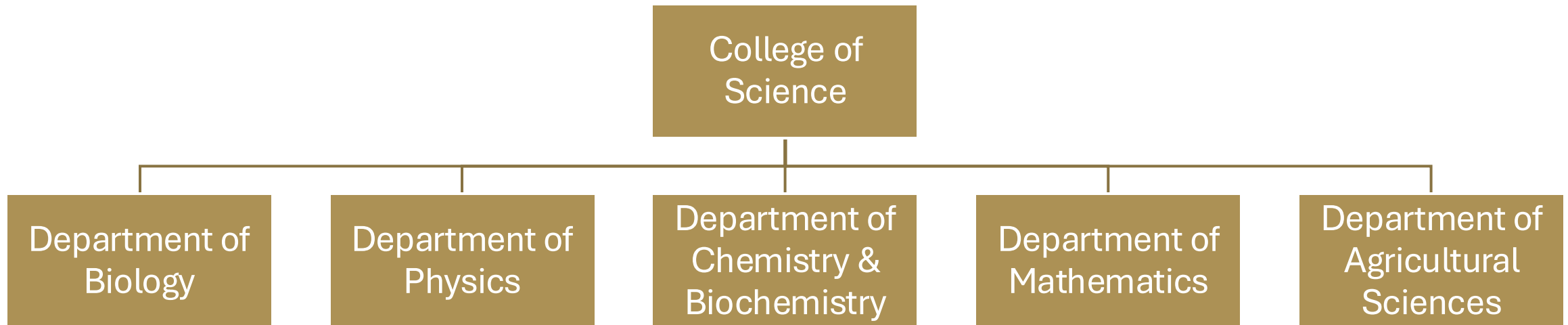
- **Fall 2023**
 - The Report of the Task Force on College Reorganization, College of Science and Engineering was submitted recommending the division of COSE to create a College of Science and a College of Engineering
- **Summer 2025**
 - Task force charged to recommend how a new College of Engineering should be constituted
 - Report completed in June 2025
- **Fall 2025 through Spring 2026**
 - Provost Aswath and Senior Vice Provost Sriraman met with every Engineering programs and some industrial advisory boards to discuss the recommendations
- **Summer 2026**
 - Seek approval from the TSUS Board of Regents and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
 - Begin implementing plan based on report recommendations and direct feedback
- **Fall 2027**
 - Formally launch College of Science and Ingram College of Engineering

Engagement and Feedback

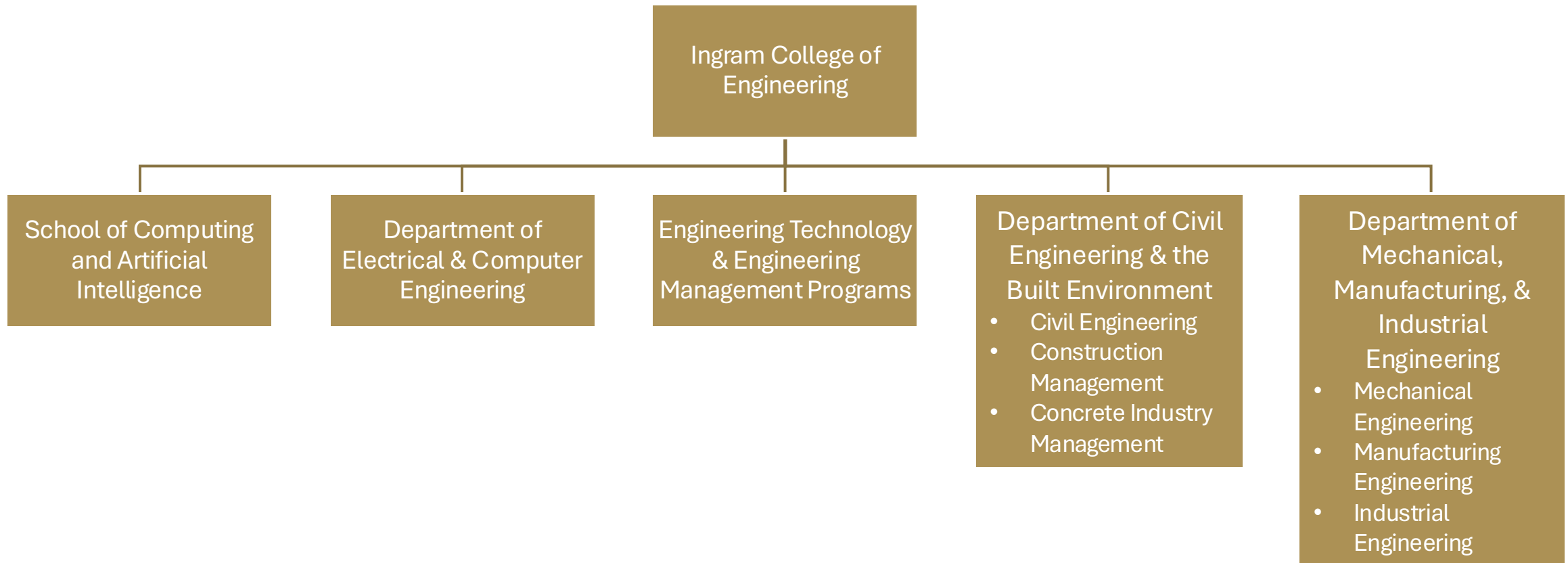
- Thank you for your participation throughout the process

- Hearing directly from so many stakeholders across the Ingram School of Engineering and advisory boards has improved this process and the organizational plan



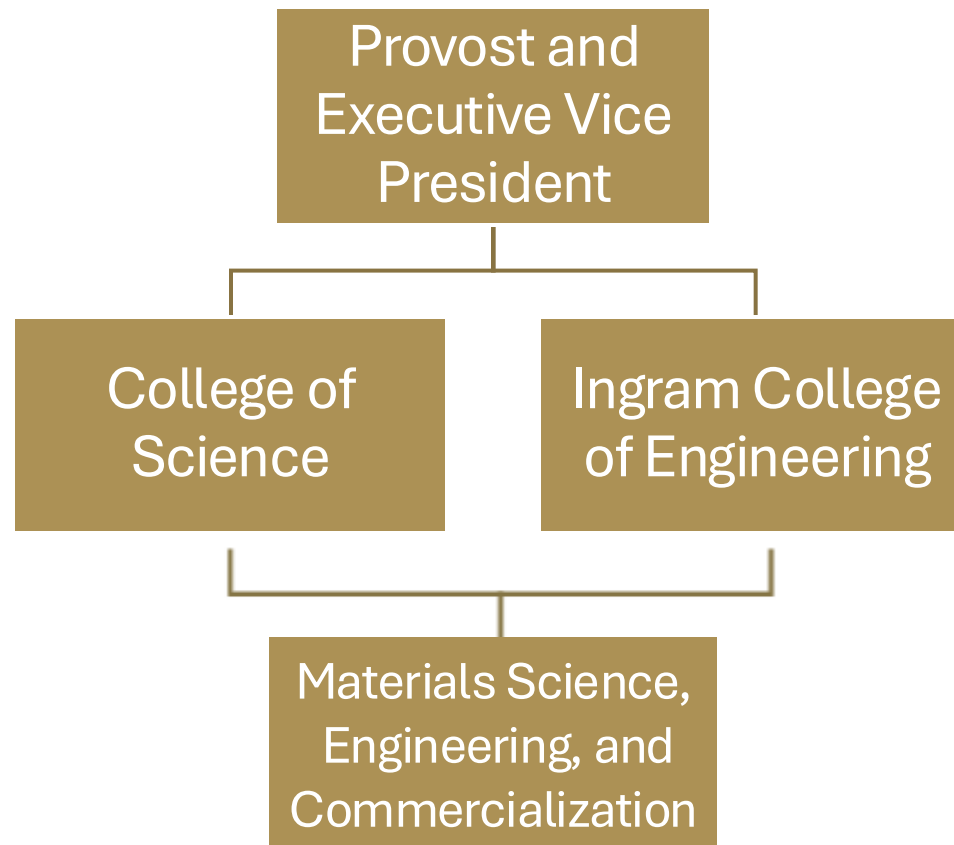
College of Science Org Chart



Ingram College of Engineering Org Chart



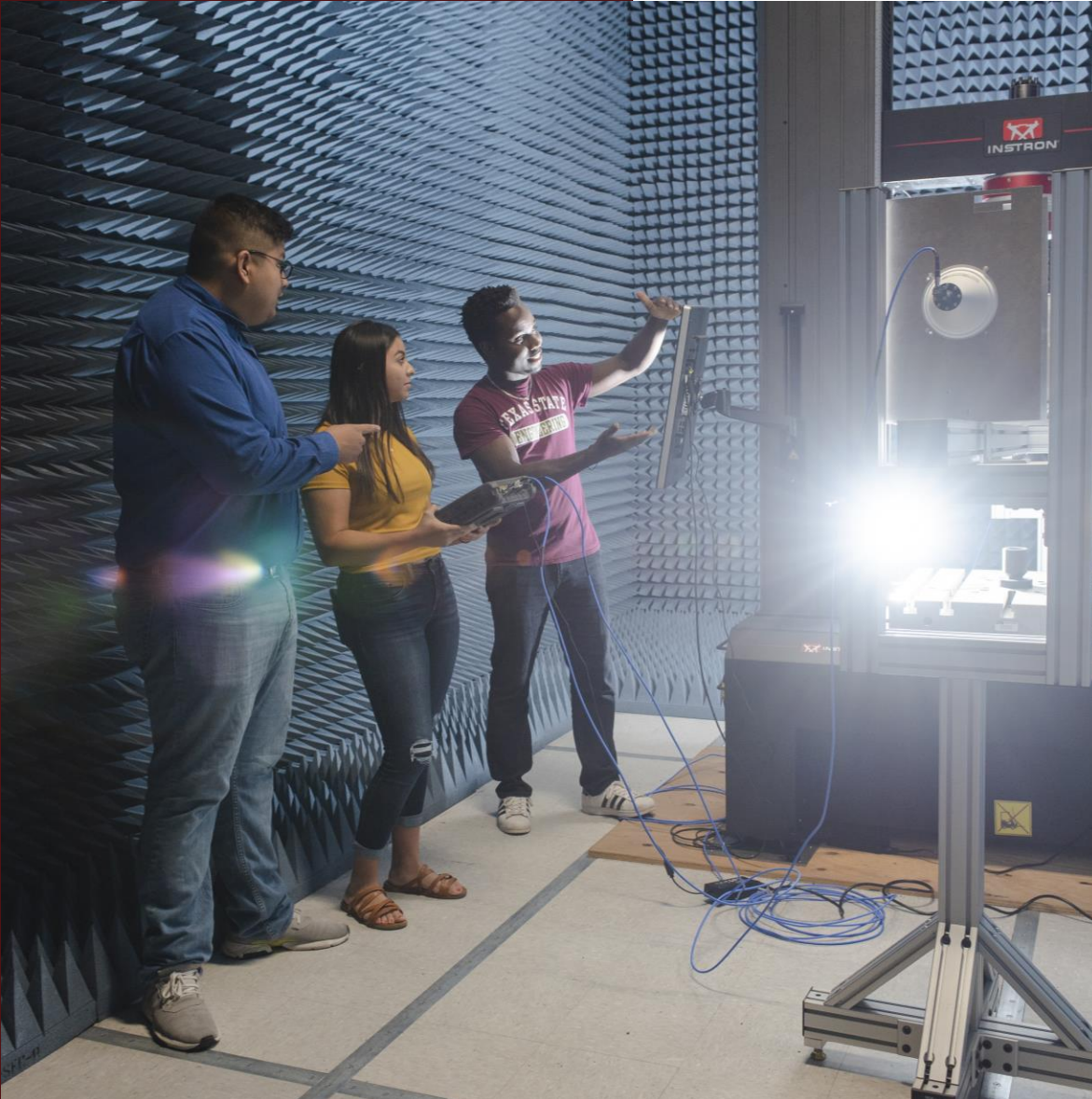
Materials Science, Engineering, and Commercialization



Program Independence

- The creation of departments that include multiple programs in the Ingram College of Engineering creates opportunities for collaboration and synergy
- Programs will retain their identities, P&T requirements, advisory boards, accreditors, and other crucial elements that ensure discipline-specific quality



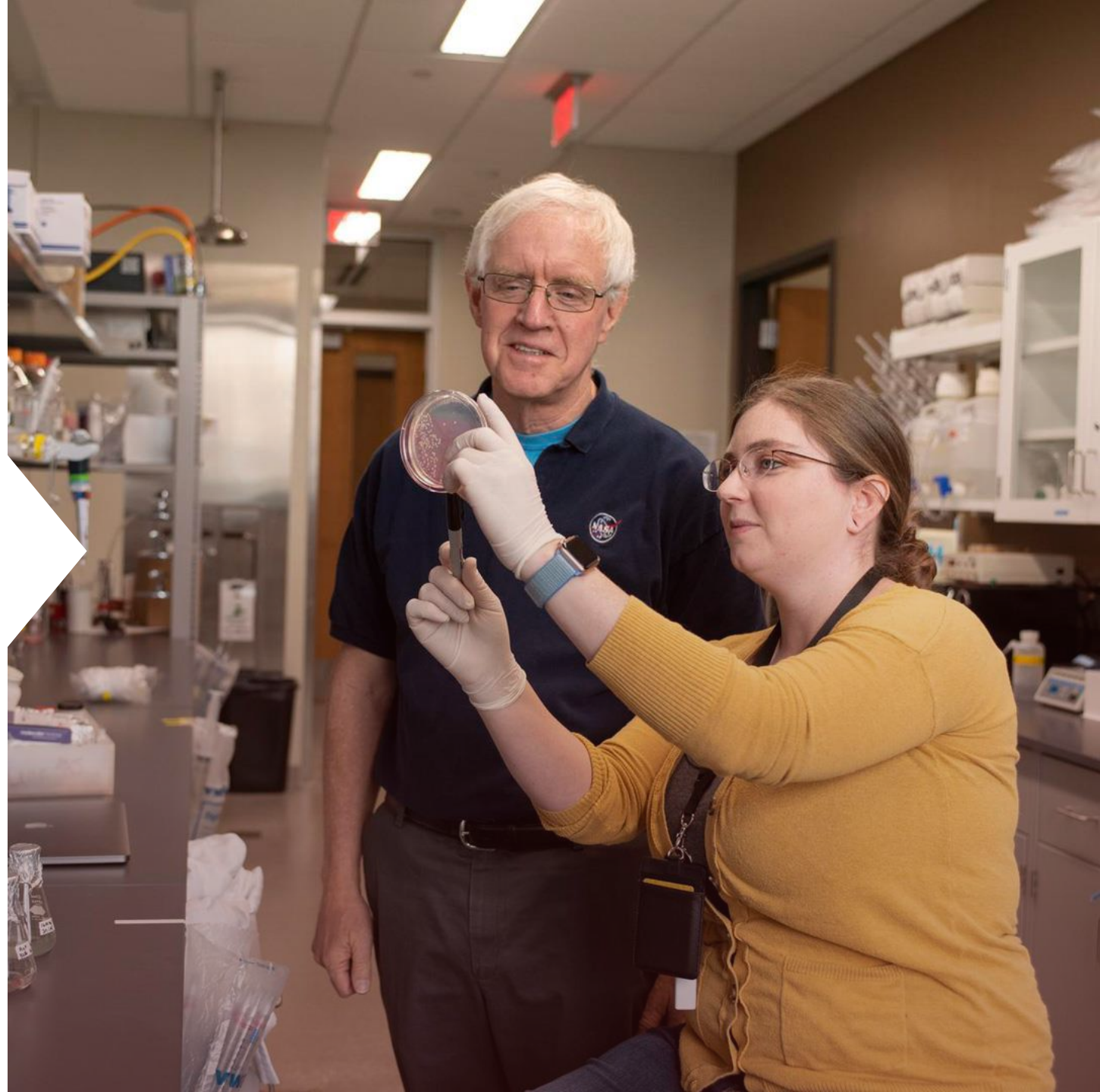


Shared Services

To ensure the success of two new colleges, shared services will be necessary. Throughout the implementation process we will work with college leadership on resource allocation and distribution with a preference for avoiding the duplication of services and gaining benefits from centralization and scale.

Leadership and Staffing

- This reorganization will result in two inaugural dean positions requiring a rigorous review process
 - Searches will begin in Fall 2026 for Fall 2027 start dates
- There will be no staff terminations due to the reorganization
 - As we move through the process, we will determine appropriate staffing levels for each college
