CHIHUAHUA, Mexico, Nov. 30 The annual soccer football season in Northern Mexico will be formally inaugurated in this city on Sunday, December 8, when the Internationals and the Spaniards clash in the initial game. Both Manager Rafael Calderon and Captain Brittingham of the Internationals are so sure of victory in the coming contest that they are prepared to issue a deft to play any team in Mexico or Texas. This deft applies particularly to Texas, especially in the cities of San Antonio and El Paso, where it is known there are soccer teams.
